

Dear Woodmont Recreation Association Member:

Enclosed you will find the 2020 membership application, fee structure, and payment options.

This year we will continue the Membership Volunteer Obligation Program (MVOP) with “sweat equity” of five (5) volunteer hours per “Family of 2+” membership and two (2) volunteer hours per “Family of 1” membership. **However, a new incentive this year is you will receive double the hours, two (2) hours credit for one (1) hour worked during the opening of the pool through Sunday May 10, 2020.** The first opportunity for double hours will be Saturday, 3/14. As we did last year, members will pay the MVOP fee as part of membership dues with a separate check (post-dated to September 15, 2020) or prepay online. When the volunteer hour commitment has been fulfilled, we will shred your un-cashed check or refund your online MVOP fee and notify you via email. Any checks remaining after Pool Closing Work Day (weekend after Labor Day) will be deposited. We hope this will add an extra incentive for you to jump in and get involved with our wonderful community, making Woodmont the best it can be, as we’d rather have your time than your money.

However, if you know that you are not planning on working volunteer hours, you can include the MVOP fee as part of your membership payment (no post-dated, separate check needed). Remember, if you have children on the swim and/or dive team, volunteer hours are required to staff meets and are separate from the MVOP hours. Also, snack bar workers are not considered for MVOP credit.

Finally, we are always looking for families and individuals who want to be a part of our Woodmont Community. If you have friends and/or family that join, make sure they mention your name and you can earn five (5) guest passes as a referral bonus!

POOL RULES

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| <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Members and guests must register at the gate - Guest fee \$5. (Books of 10 Guest Passes are available for purchase)2. Guests are expected to follow all pool rules. If they fail to comply, guests may be asked to leave the property by the lifeguards.3. A member must be 11 years-old or rising 6th grader to enter pool without an adult.4. ADULT Guests are limited to seven (7) visits per season. Only members can purchase guest passes.5. Minor members with guests under 18 must have permission of the adult member to be admitted.6. Babysitters must be at least 15 and remain with child at all times. Babysitters may not bring guests.7. No one over 6 years-old allowed in baby pool. Parents are responsible for discipline in baby pool at all times and must remain in baby pool enclosure if child is in baby pool.8. Pool will be closed if water temperature is less than 72 degrees.9. Pool will be closed for 30 minutes when thunder is heard and for 30 minutes upon the sight of lightning.10. Admission will be denied to anyone with illness, injury, or condition which could endanger others.11. Persons intoxicated or under the influence of drugs will not be admitted, asked to leave the premise, and could result in forfeiting your membership.12. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas. This includes e-cigarettes.13. No loitering allowed at the front gate or on the grounds.14. No pets allowed.15. No gum or food allowed in the pool. | <ol style="list-style-type: none">16. No loose-fitting jewelry is allowed to be worn while in the pool.17. No glass containers allowed inside the gates.18. Swim diapers are the only diapers allowed in the pool. They are available for purchase at the snack bar.19. No floats allowed in pool unless approved by manager. Children 3 or under may use floats if supervised by an adult in the pool.20. No running on pool deck or in the building.21. No horseplay in the pool, pool area or building (including restrooms & game room).22. Pool basketball is to be played from within the pool only and only with the approved WRA balls. No shooting from the deck or while jumping into the pool.23. No hanging on the basketball goals.24. All swimmers under 10 must pass a swim test under lifeguard supervision before using the diving boards or swimming in the diving well.25. Diving well is restricted to diving from the diving boards.26. No one is allowed in the diving well to catch a child from the boards.27. Only front approach is allowed on the diving boards.28. No throwing objects to those on the diving boards.29. No diving towards the sides of the pool from the diving boards.30. No skateboards, scooters, bicycles, or any other mode of transport allowed in the pool area, building, or front porch.31. No food, drinks, or wet bathing suits allowed in the game room.32. Access to the upstairs is not permitted without authorized permission. |
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WRA Member Volunteer Obligation Program (MVOP)

The Woodmont Recreation Association is a wonderful family-oriented organization where everyone takes pride in making it more than an outdoor pool. We believe we are a Community. It is also a non-profit volunteer association, which depends solely on membership dues and volunteer hours to support, manage, and benefit the organization.

Volunteer obligations are 'sweat equity' based. They allow us to keep our costs reasonable and ensure Woodmont Recreational Association remains functional, safe and financially secure.

Because of our limited resources, it is necessary to ask you to volunteer time in addition to your annual dues. **Any Woodmont member or guest over the age of 12 is welcome to use their time and talent in the MVOP program.** As an added bonus, middle school and high school students that volunteer can also apply those hours to their community services requirements at their home school.

IMPORTANT: Please note that you need to report your hours worked to the board member in charge of tracking them. This will be done either via a signup sheet or via the email address can be found on the bulletin board at the pool. This will be the official tally of hours worked for MVOP. If you do not report your hours via signup sheet or email, then we will not count whatever hours you may have worked.

We are asking you to write a check for the fees upfront (**post-dated September 15, 2020**), but your check will be shredded once the volunteer commitment is completed and you will receive an email with a confirmation. **For online enrollment**, your account will be refunded for the MVOP fee once you have completed your hours.

The following outlines the volunteer expectation from each membership:

Family of 2+ Membership:	Five (5) Hours minimum
Family of 1 Membership:	Two (2) Hours minimum

PLEASE NOTE:

- For the initial work days where we get the pool ready for the summer, you will receive double the credit for the hours worked (i.e. work one (1) hour and get two (2) hours credit).
- A maximum of two (2) hours for a "Family of 2+" and a maximum of one (1) hour for a "Family of 1" can be earned by working the social events.

If you are not interested or able to volunteer and would prefer to simply pay the \$125/\$75 fee upfront that is perfectly fine as well. If this is your selection, your MVOP fee should be included with your membership fee check, rather than a separate check.

Please note, volunteer obligations requested as part of the Aquatics Programs (Swim and Dive Teams) are managed separately and are not part of the Membership Volunteer Obligation Program (MVOP)

Also note, the Snack Bar Volunteers are not either counted as part of the Membership Volunteer Obligation Program (MVOP)

MEMBERSHIP DUES FEE SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS: 1) All fees must be paid in full or set up in the online installment program prior to use of any of the facilities; 2) A child must be included in family rate if two (2) years old by May 16, 2020; 3) Only immediate family (see definition below) members may be enrolled in a family membership; 4) All information on both sides of this application & the MVOP commitment form must be completed before it will be considered by the Board for approval. WRA is a private not for profit facility. All membership applications are subject to review and approval by the Board.

FAMILY DEFINITION: An “immediate family” is defined as people living in the same household/address. Exceptions will be granted per Woodmont Board discretion. An exception request must be submitted via email to Membership@Woodmont4Fun.com
